About us:

The goal of IABAT weekend school, Allah (ST) willing, is to sustain and progressively advance the learning of our youth based on the Holy Quran and the way of our beloved Prophet Muhammad (sawa) and his Holy Ahlul Bayt (as), and strengthen their identity as Muslims. We will strive to build this educational atmosphere by using all the resources in our community and by coming together to serve this purpose.

Approach:

We will use a structured curriculum which covers proper recitation and understanding of the Holy Quran, Islamic studies which include history, fundamentals and akhlaq, as well as contemporary issues relevant to our youth.

The school's goal is to continuously refine the approach to teaching so that our students get the most out of their education. This year we are adding new books to the curriculum and incorporating different methods of teaching, which we envision will facilitate the process of learning for our very diverse student-body.

New Initiatives:

We will be implementing some new teaching approaches this year to improve student learning, particularly for Holy Quran and Arabic. Each school day will begin with a 15-minute all-student assembly in which general topics will be discussed with the Resident Alim along with questions and answers.

In addition, the first part of the Holy Quran/Arabic class will be dedicated to proper recitation and pronunciation. Dedicated teachers with expertise in these areas will rotate from class to class and will work with each student. In addition, we will sponsor the formation of clubs, which will focus on specific student interests and the goal of which will be not only to foster learning but also encourage social interaction.

Finally, the school will implement a mentorship program through which one of the older students will be paired with one or two younger students. The purpose of this will be to develop common projects for special occasions (e.g. Muharram) and provide scholastic help to the younger students.
